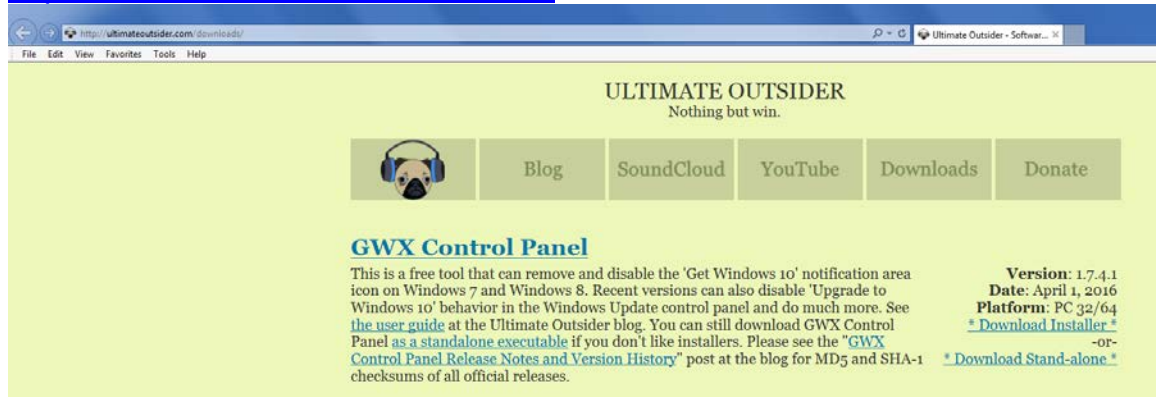

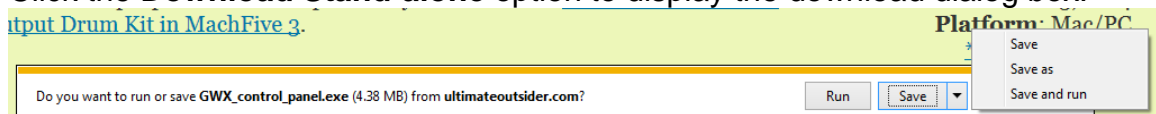

Install the GWX Control Panel

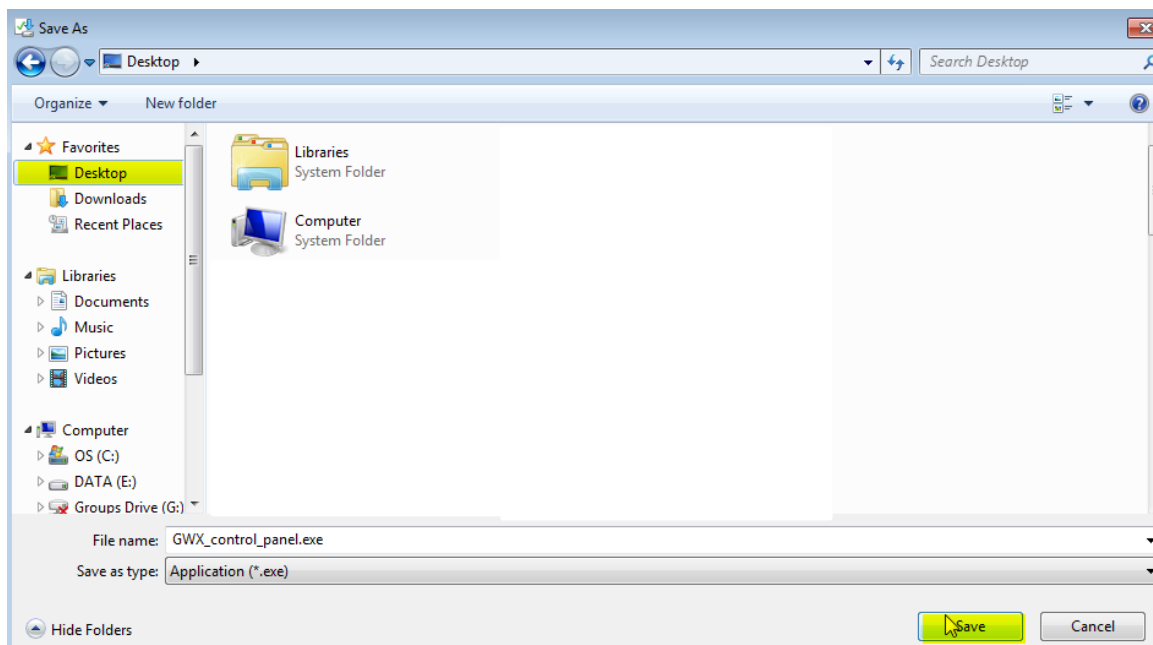
1. Click the following link to display the **Ultimate Outsider** downloads page.

2. Locate the **GWX Control Panel** section.
3. Click the **Download Stand-alone** option to display the download dialog box.



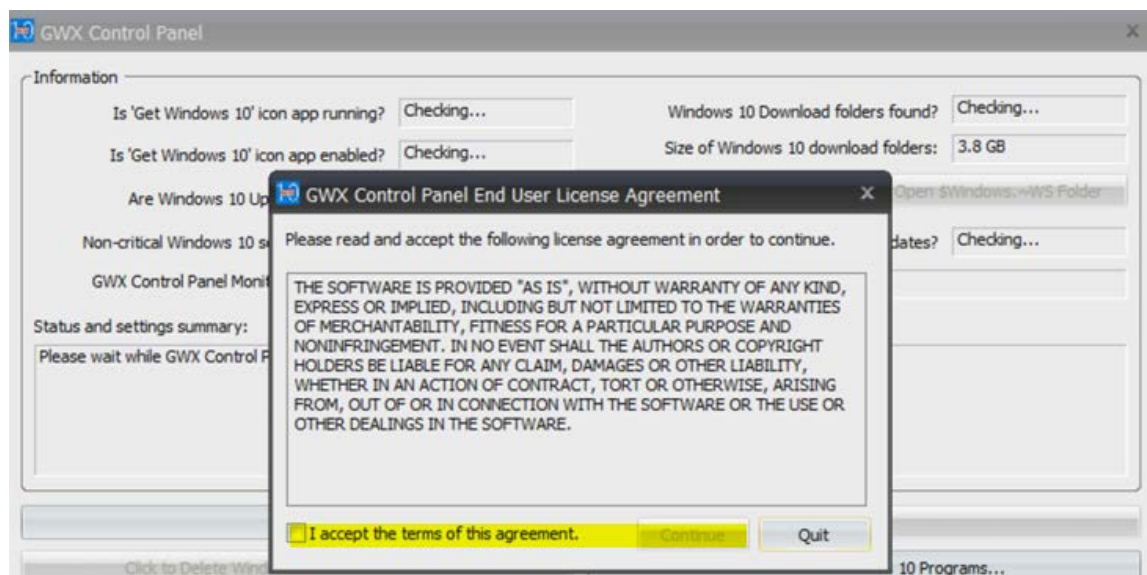
4. Select **Save As** from the **Save** button drop-down to display the **Save As** window.



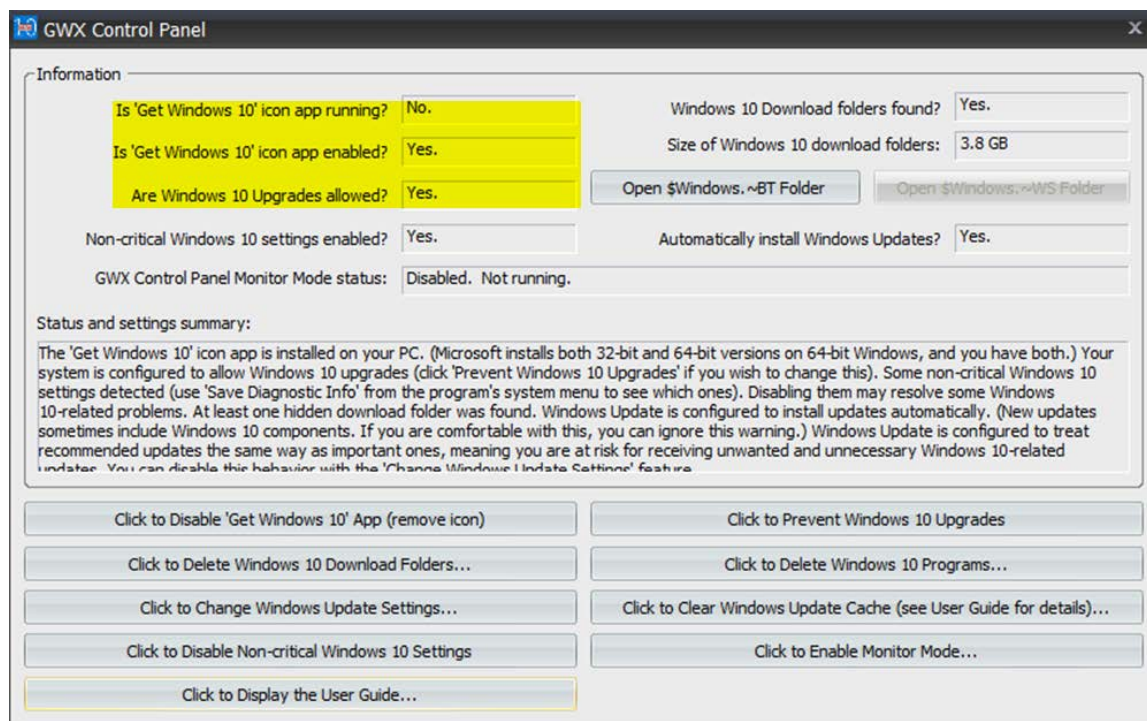
5. Navigate to the Desktop (click the **Desktop** icon) and click the **Save** button to complete the installation.

Use the GWX Control Panel

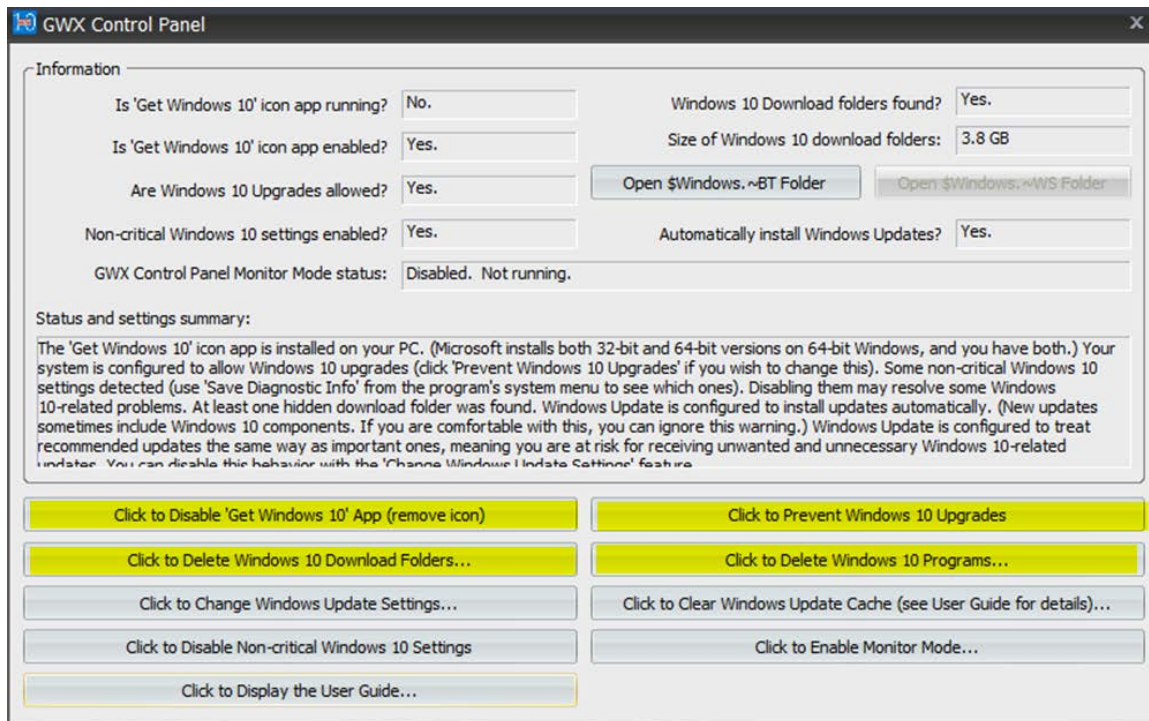
1. Click the **GWX Control Panel** icon on the Desktop to open the **GWX Control Panel** screen with a **GWX Control Panel End User License Agreement** window in front.



2. Check the **I accept...** checkbox and click the **Continue** button to close the window.

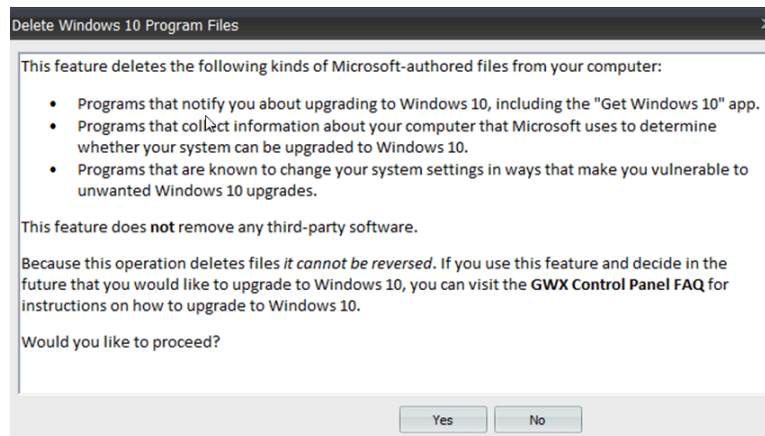


3. Note the **Windows 10** settings displayed in the upper left portion of the **Information** section.



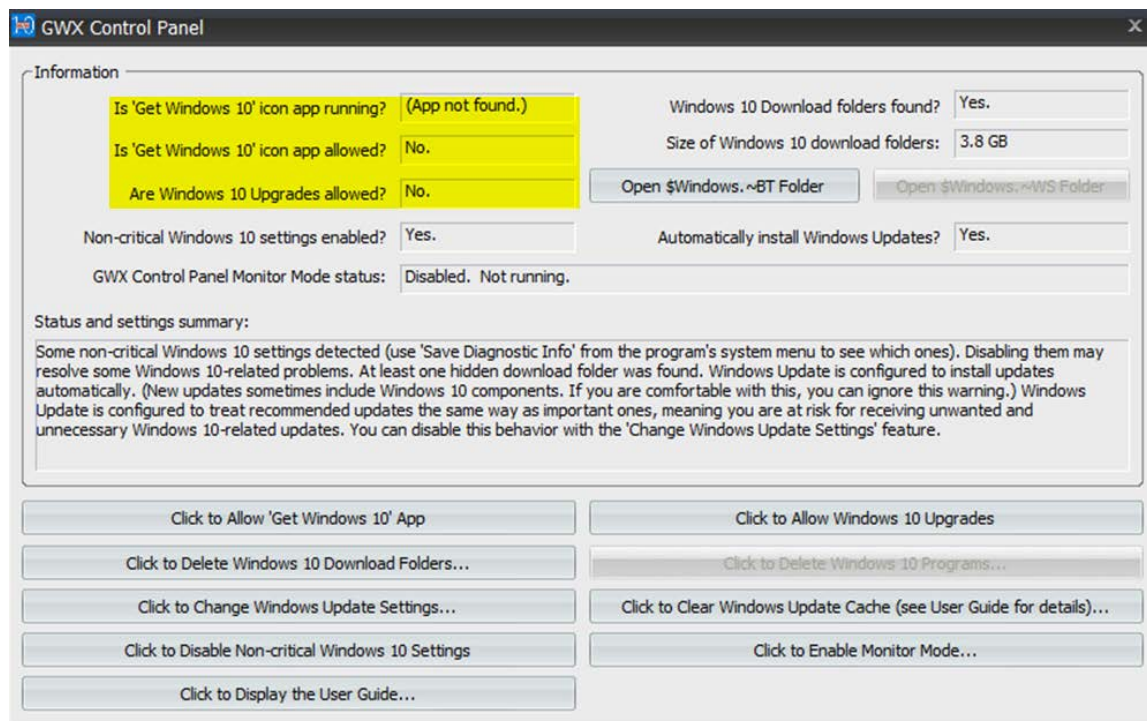
4. Complete the following procedure to remove **Windows 10** update and installation files:

1. Click the **Click to Disable 'Get Windows 10' App (remove icon)** button.
2. Click the **Click to Delete Windows 10 Download Folders...** button.
3. Click the **Click to Prevent Windows 10 Upgrades** button.
4. Click the **Click to Delete Windows 10 Programs...** button to display a confirmation window.



5. Click the **Yes** button to close the confirmation window.

► When clicked, a **Delete/Disable** button becomes an **Allow** button that can be clicked to restore previous settings.



- Note the modified **Windows 10** settings displayed in the **Information** section. These values indicate the safe removal and continued blocking of **Windows 10** update and installation files for this machine.
