### 3.1 V6 Update Summary

As a part of this release, the following updates and defect resolutions were made to the system.

#### • Security Enhancement

Security setting must be enabled to access AR Posting menu.

#### • Field Expansion Purchase Order Number field has been increased to 20 characters.

- **Committed Quantities Fix** Kit items and Work Orders properly designate quantities to committed when updated at the POS. Accurate quantities displayed upon running **Cleanup** within the **Resets** menu.
- Removed Unnecessary IMS Options Mask Merchant Copy Credit Card # check box in IMS Properties>POS and Open DataSource in the File dropdown are no longer necessary and have been removed.
- Transaction Receipt Addition POS receipts, as well as IMS invoices, will display the Merchant ID# on credit card transactions.
- Layaway Void Fix Void layaway/tax conflict resolved.
