Overview

The RTG® Retail Technology Group (RTG) provides this document as a high-level summary of the latest release of the RTG AXIS software system.

In addition to enhancements described in this document a number of reported system defects have also been addressed.

Integrated NICS E-Check

The integrated NICS E-Check will submit customer information obtained via the AXIS E4473 directly to the FBI via an XML feed provided and maintained by the FBI. All paperwork and submission of required documents for the use of the API will be the responsibility of each individual AXIS user, as required by the FBI.

This feature is designed to only be used by FFL holders in states that do not act as an FBI NICS Point of Contacts. [FBI NICS Point of Contact](#) states are those in which FFL's contact a state authority opposed to directly contacting the FBI in order to conduct a background check.

These steps must be taken to gain access to the FBI's API

FBI API Setup

1. Contact FBI Liaison [Nicholas Casey](#), to obtain the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
2. Submit MOU and any information requested by FBI contact. Standard information is as follows.
 - a. Name of FFL holder
 - b. FFL Number
 - c. External IP address that traffic will be coming from. Contact internet provider to set this up.
 - i. Note: This is not just setting a static IP on a machine in the building, but setting a static IP leaving the building. Please contact internet provider if needed.
 - d. City and state that IP address is located. Also, contact internet provider to confirm this information.
3. Generate and submit SSL Certificate. Instructions will be provided by the FBI contact.

▶ This SSL Certificate will need to be renewed on a yearly basis

AXIS Setup

Once the FBI MOU process is complete, the API and employee permissions can be setup in AXIS. Contact RTG support to assist with turning the feature on as it will be off by default.
